Join us on Friday, January 22 at 7pm for an evening of prayer, worship and outreach in the aftermath of the devastating earthquake in Haiti. Our worship, in the quiet and moving style of Taize, will feature hymns in both English and French, as well as prayer in both languages. Our worship space will be adorned with Haitian art and artifacts to serve as touchstones for prayer.

Following the service, several organizations will be on hand to educate people about Haiti as well as offer ways to bring relief to Haiti, including representatives from the Haiti Outreach Mission (H.O.M.), which was founded 15 years ago at St. David's. Each year H.O.M. sends mission teams to Mirebalais, Haiti to work in medical clinics.

Participants are invited to bring the following needed items to St. David's for the next H.O.M. mission trip:

- Polyvisol infants vitamins (store brand ok, as long as it's for infants)
- Adult vitamins (90 tabs at least per bottle)
- Tubes of antibiotic creams (any brand/generic)
- Ziploc-style sandwich baggies for medicine transport
